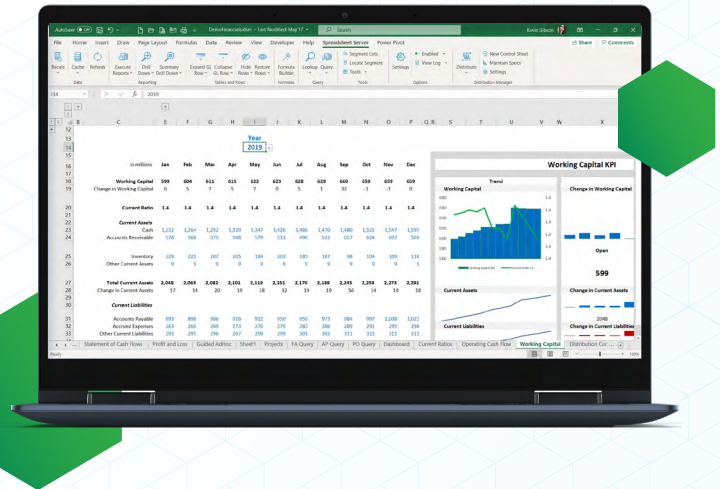
But thanks to **Spreadsheet Server** from insightsoftware, Baptist Health didn't experience the headaches so commonly associated with ERP migration. The organization moved from Lawson to Infor FSM last year and, as Accounting Manager Darla Cruz recalled, "I think it went pretty smoothly. Of course, with any migration, you will run into a few snags here and there. But," she continued, "overall, I think the migration to Infor FSM was very successful."

Leveraging Spreadsheet Server for a Smooth ERP Transition

Spreadsheet Server is an intuitive Microsoft Excel add-in that integrates with 140+ on-premises and cloud-based data sources to provide users with access to their live data, directly in Excel for reporting and analysis.

Because it could integrate with both Lawson and Infor FSM simultaneously, Baptist Health was able to move from the legacy ERP to the new without any disruption to its finance operations.

Without the burdensome need to design and develop new reports or to train personnel in the use of new reporting software Cruz's team could support business as usual without committing the time, expense, and risk typically associated with ERP migration. Spreadsheet Server provided a strong sense of continuity during an otherwise disruptive process.



How Spreadsheet Server simplified Baptist Health's ERP migration:

- ▶ **Seamless Data Access:** With near-real-time data access, data is updated in a one- to three-hour window rather than once daily, significantly speeding up the reporting process.
- ▶ **Native Excel Integration:** Financial and operational reporting is done within the familiar Excel environment, eliminating the need for extensive product training.
- ▶ **Reusable Reports:** Reports automatically roll forward to the next reporting period, making it easy to maintain and update reports without time-consuming copying and pasting.

"We didn't run into any delays in terms of our month-end close and being able to get our files out in a timely manner," Cruz said. "The migration didn't slow us down at all."

Streamlined Reporting

One of the greatest advantages of using Spreadsheet Server—especially during ERP migration—is its direct ERP connection. By pulling data directly from the ERP, Cruz's team is spared the time-consuming and error-prone process of manually downloading data from Lawson or Infor FSM and reformatting it for Excel. This gives them the agility to create more reports, more often.

"Instead of waiting for data to update once daily, when someone makes a journal entry then transaction data updates within a one-to three-hour window, so we know we have the most current data. That's particularly important at month-end when we're in a time crunch," Cruz said.

Flexibility and Agility

With its sprawling network of hospitals and hundreds of clinics, Baptist Health generates a huge number of internal transactions every month. Spreadsheet Server's adaptability has become a cornerstone of its operational efficiency. The ability to pull data at a high, organization-wide level or narrow parameters to a single clinic within the system is incredibly useful—it empowers Cruz's team to see the bigger picture and get a stronger grasp of the organization's financial health.

"The way we're structured, there are a lot of moving parts between these different organizations. So, that level of detail is very

important," Cruz explained. "Spreadsheet Server helps us narrow it down to the details that we need."

Cruz rarely needs to contact Spreadsheet Server support for serious issues; usually support calls are to add or remove users in Baptist Health's internship program. Whether managing user access or getting answers to software functionality questions, Cruz describes her support experiences as "simply amazing," with highlights like:

"We get a resolution to our questions and issues very quickly."

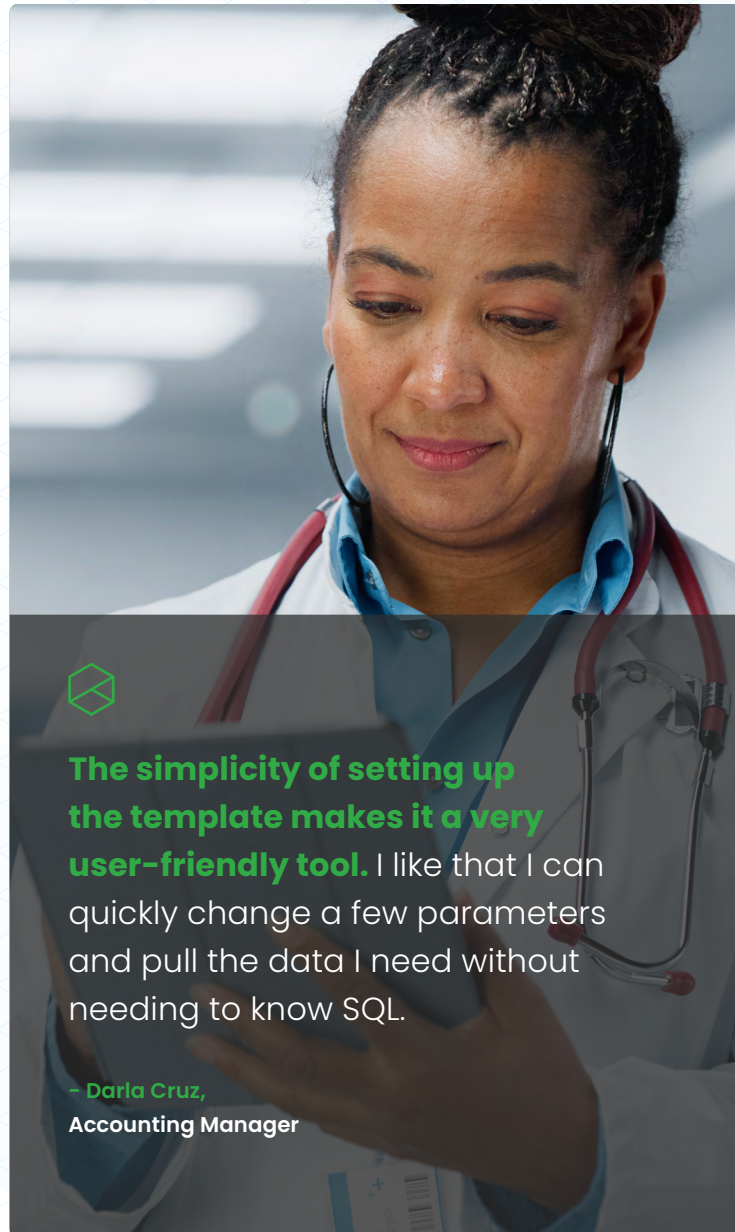


What's Next for Baptist Health

Cruz noted that Spreadsheet Server is used much more by managers like herself than by frontline accounting staff and that training more members of her team in the software is a goal.
